1. Definitions



Definitions



- Non-perishable materials that do not have a shelf life or characteristics that would materially change when exposed to the elements.
- Material samples tested, approved and certified for incorporation into the Work.

Examples of materials considered as MOH:

- Structural steel
- Reinforcing steel
- Pre-cast concrete elements
- Illumination poles
- Traffic signal poles
- Other non-perishable materials at TxDOT discretion

Examples of materials not considered as MOH:

- Cement
- Lime
- Fine aggregate
- Concrete mixtures
- HMAC mixtures
- Joint sealing materials
- Other perishable materials



2. Meetings





Materials on Hand Meetings



DB Contractor conducts a meeting with TxDOT in advance of NTP2 to discuss:



MOH anticipated to be incorporated into the Work.

TxDOT expectations for Buy America compliance documentation required by DB GC Item 6.

Allowable permanent incorporation of foreign iron and steel, under the minimal use exceptions.

Tracking of the temporary use of foreign iron, steel and construction materials.

DB Contractor conducts additional meetings as needed to discuss changes to the anticipated Materials on Hand.



3. Payment



Delivery and Storage



TxDOT will not pay for materials not yet incorporated in the Work unless materials qualify as MOH by meeting the following conditions:

- Delivered to the Site.
- Delivered and stored by DB Contractor in a <u>location approved</u> by TxDOT.
- Stored at a Supplier's <u>fabrication site</u> <u>approved by</u> <u>TxDOT</u>, prior to submitting MOH request.

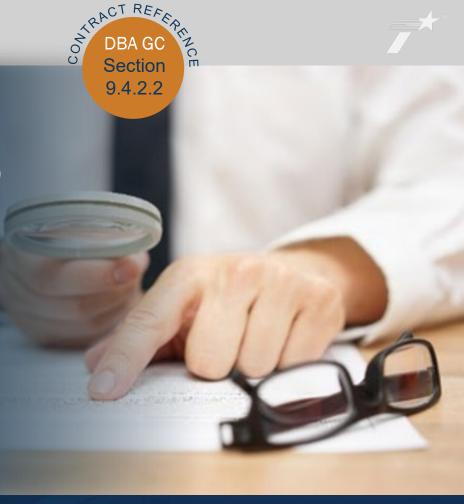
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If storage site of such materials is not approved by TxDOT, then DB Contractor accepts full responsibility for any and all costs associated the storage of such material (property taxes for example)

Prior to submitting MOH invoices for payment, the Independent Quality Firm (IQF) must:

- Inspects and certifies that MOH is in conformance with approved materials submittals and specifications in accordance with Design-Build Quality Assurance Program (DB QAP)
- Authorizes MOH for construction

Payment for MOH does not constitute acceptance of the material.



Compliance Documentation





Responsibilities of DB Contractor prior to payment:

Ensure MOH meets
 Contract Documents
 requirements for
 incorporation into
 the Work.

 Provide TxDOT proper bills of sale or other documentation, in writing, and in a form acceptable to TxDOT showing that materials are free and clear of all Liens.

Invoice Documentation

DBA GC Section 9.4.2.2

DB Contractor provides invoices and documentation seven days in advance of the Draw Request



The <u>seven days</u> allows TxDOT time to verify requested amount

Verification of requested amounts is a condition of payment for MOH.

Invoices <u>shall not include freight and</u> <u>handling costs</u>.

Payment <u>must not exceed actual cost of</u> <u>materials</u> as established by invoice or the total cost of the associated Payment Activity less reasonable placement, freight and storage costs, whichever is less.

Invoices must also include **Buy America compliance documentation**.



TxDOT pays only the amount represented by these invoices as is consistent with the reasonable cost of such materials.

Buy America Compliance Documentation

DB Contractor shall comply with Buy America requirements set forth in **Exhibit 7 to Attachment 3-1**:

- Submittals are notarized original forms:
 - Form 2806 Construction Materials Buy
 America Certification
 - > For construction materials, which include:
 - Non-ferrous metals
 - Plastic and polymer-based products
 - o Glass
 - Lumber, or dry wall
 - Form 1818 Material Statement
 - For iron and steel materials





Buy America – Item 4 Scope of Work

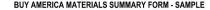
DB Contractor shall complete and submit to TxDOT:

Buy America Materials Summary Form as part of Exhibit 3 to Attachment 4-2,

- Quality Management Plan (QMP) submittals to TxDOT: Table 4-3
 - Submittal schedule: Monthly
 - Department Action: For Information

Project shall be subject to FHWA Utility Requirements:

- Build America, Buy America Act (BABA Act)
- 23 CFR Part 645 Subpart A (Utility Adjustment Work)
- 23 CFR 635.410 (Buy America)

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Section 4.3.6

Receipt of Payment Documentation

DB Contractor must provide a paid invoice within <u>sixty (60)</u> <u>days</u> of receiving payment for Materials on Hand





- If DB Contractor fails to provide such evidence of receipt of payment within <u>sixty</u> (60) <u>days</u>
 - ➤ DB Contractor will not be eligible for any additional payments for MOH.
 - ➤ Payment will be withheld from future Draw Requests in amount equal to the payments for MOH that were not supported by paid invoice.



The total amount eligible for payment for MOH shall not exceed the cumulative maximum payment schedule amount.

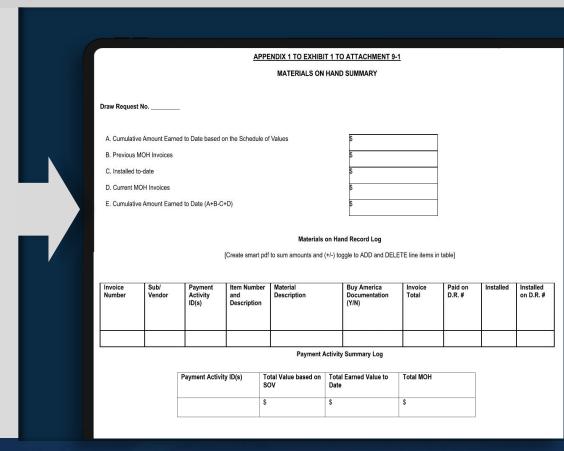

Limitations on Payment



DBA GC Section 9.4.2.5

MOH costs and charges included in Draw Request for materials that are subsequently lost, damaged, unsatisfactory or impacted by Nonconforming Work <u>may be</u> deducted from subsequent Draw Requests as deemed appropriate considering the insurance coverages and the replacement costs.

Payment for MOH furnished and delivered does not exceed the amount paid by DB Contractor as evidenced by a bill of sale supported by a paid invoice.

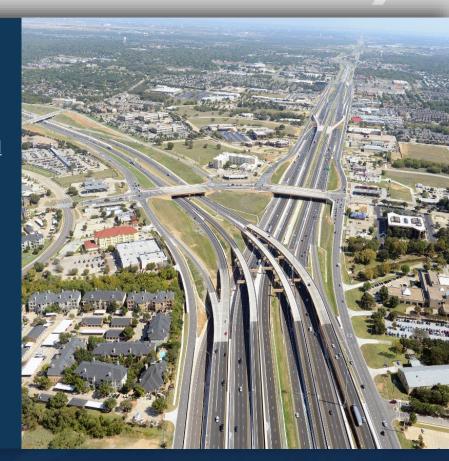
