Questions

- 1. Are there any preclusions? Answer: No preclusions are anticipated.
- Is an EA required for all 3 Segments? Answer: The type of environmental document has not been determined. However, all 3 segments will require scope and effort for environmental services.
- 3. Will this presentation be posted online? Answer: This presentation will be made available and posted on the PEPS Division website.
- 4. Has it been determined who will be required to attend the interview? Answer: A determination has not been made as far as who will be required to attend the interview.
- 5. For the HUB goal, can the be self-fulfilled? Answer: This will require a DBE goal since it is federal, and Consultants can self-fulfill these requirements and apply toward the total goal.
- 6. Segment 6 includes the ENV for all the three segments. Does that mean that only the contract for Segment 6 will include ENV services or all three contracts will include ENV services and the overall document will be combined under Segment 6? Answer: All 3 segments will require scope and effort for environmental services.
- 7. Have you determined how the Segments will be assigned to the awarded firms? Answer: Segment 6 is the most comprehensive with highest anticipated cost. Once awards are determined, the Consultant ranked highest will be given the 1st opportunity to choose this segment.
- 8. Will a Deputy Project Manager (DPM) be part of the team? Answer: Yes, a DPM will be part of the team.
- Are there slides 28 and 29?
 Answer: Slides 28 and 29 were intended for any clarifications of the southern tie-in of Segment 4. However, Segments 1,2,3 are not part of this procurement.
- 10. What do you anticipate the length of the contract to be?

Answer: Per the approved BCM, it will be for a duration of 5 years.

- 12. Can the DPM have a shared Task Lead (TL) role? Answer: Yes, the DPM can have a shared TL role.
- 13. Is the project federally funded? Answer: Yes, the project is federally funded.
- 14. Are ramping adjustments assumed on I-35?Answer: Yes, ramp adjustments are assumed on I-35 and IAJR effort is anticipated.
- 15. Are the Consultants on Segments 1,2,3 precluded? Answer: Consultants on Segments 1,2,3 are not precluded.
