








Comptroller's anticipated revenues available to TxDOT approx. \$1B less than expected over FY 2025-2027

REGIONAL PRIORITY FUNDING: STATE HIGHWAY 130 CONCESSION PAYMENTS


The Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (CAMPO) manages toll revenue funds from the SH 130 Concession Agreement, related to Segments 5 and 6 of the toll road through the TxDOT Austin District. As part of the agreement, TxDOT is working with the MPO to select future projects on which these funds would be used, located on state highways within the region. CAMPO has identified a list of on-system corridors (see table below) to begin planning, project development, and environmental analysis work, using the SH 130 toll revenue funds. Due to the unique nature of this funding source, the projects must be listed in the UTP document and approved through Commission action.
