#### 6. Legislative Appropriations Request

**116751** Consider the adoption of the Texas Department of Transportation's Fiscal Year 2026-2027 Legislative Appropriations Request (<u>Presentation</u>) (<u>MO</u>) Every two years the Texas Department of Transportation (department) is required to submit a Legislative Appropriations Request (LAR) for the upcoming biennium to be considered by the Texas Legislature. The proposed LAR describes the level of funding, method of finance, and fulltime equivalents associated with the department's strategies for the Fiscal Year 2026-2027

biennium. State law requires the department to deliver the LAR to the Texas Transportation Commission in an open meeting not later than the 30th day before the date the department submits the LAR to the Legislative Budget Board and the Governor's Office.

## (Presentation) (MO)

The Unified Transportation Program (UTP) is a 10-year statewide plan for transportation project development. The Project Selection Process (PSP) is approved annually and describes the funding categories and process for selecting transportation projects. State law authorizes the Texas Transportation Commission to acquire real property before a final decision is made as to the location of a transportation facility. The Texas Department of Transportation desires to purchase property on US 281 in Comal County for possible use in or in connection with a transportation facility.

The Texas Transportation Commission must approve the sales, transfers, and exchanges of state rights of way and other real properties that are no longer needed for a state highway purpose. State law requires the Texas Transportation Commission (commission) to establish a compliance program, which must include a Compliance Division to oversee the program. The Compliance Division is responsible for acting to prevent and detect serious breaches of the Texas Department of Transportation (department) policy, fraud, waste, and abuse of office, including any acts of criminal conduct within the department. The Compliance Division is required to provide a monthly report to the commission regarding investigations and a summary of information relating to trends and recommendations.

#### (2) Quarterly Investment Report

Quarterly Investment Report for all of the funds invested at the direction of the Texas Transportation Commission (<u>Report</u>)

This is a presentation of the quarterly investment report for the investment of: (1) funds held by the Bank of New York Mellon, as trustee, under the Indenture of Trust securing the Central Texas Turnpike System toll revenue obligations; (2) funds for the pre-paid TxTag account held by the Bank of New York Mellon, acting as custodian; (3) funds held by Amegy Bank, a Division of ZB, National Association, as trustee, under the Trust Agreement securing the I-35EManaged Lanes Project toll revenue obligations; and (4) funds held by U.S. Bank National Association, as trustee, under the Master Trust Agreement securing the SH 249 System toll revenue obligations.

#### d. Finance

#### (1) Grimes and Montgomery Counties

Consider the approval of the SH 249 System annual budget of revenues, operating and maintenance expenses, major maintenance expenditures, and capital expenditures (<u>MO</u>)
