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4. Contracts

Consider the award or rejection of contracts for highway construction and routine maintenance contracts (Presentation)

These proposed minute orders contain information concerning the receipt of bids for highway improvement contracts. The Texas Department of Transportation may reschedule receipt of bids for those projects where the Texas Transportation Commission (commission) rejects all bids. Those bids accepted by the commission will result in conditional contract awards to the low bidders. Contract award conditions may involve securing funding from other sources, the contractor's ability to satisfy statutory requirements, or other requirements as outlined in the project bid proposal.

- a. **Highway Improvements and Other Transportation Facilities (MO)**

5. Aviation

Various Counties - Consider the award of federal non-primary entitlement grant funding, federal apportionment grant funding, Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act grant funding, and state grant funding for airport improvement projects at various locations ([MO](#))

Federal law authorizes the award of federal non-primary entitlement grant funding, federal apportionment grant funding, and Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act grant funding to preserve and improve the state's general aviation system. State law authorizes the award of state grant funding for capital improvement projects.

6. Promulgation of Administrative Rules Under Title 43, Texas Administrative Code, and the Administrative Procedures Act, Government Code, Chapter 2001:

Rule Proposal

Chapter 9 - Contract and Grant Management

Repeal of §9.4 (Civil Rights-Title VI Compliance), new §9.4 (Design-Build Contract Claim Procedure), and amendments to §9.2 (Contract Claim Procedure), §9.6 (Contract Claim Procedure for Comprehensive Development Agreements and Certain Design-Build Contracts), and §9.8 (Enhanced Contract and Performance Monitoring) concerning Design-Build Contract Claim Procedures ([MO](#))

This proposed rulemaking adds a new rule which provides a new dispute resolution process for a contract claim concerning a design-build contract authorized by Subchapter F, Chapter 223 of the Transportation Code and amends §9.2 and §9.6 to clarify which rules are used to process certain claims. This proposed rulemaking also repeals the existing §9.4 and combines the requirements with §9.8 creating the Enhanced Contract and Performance Monitoring; Civil Rights - Title VI Compliance Section.

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7. Contested Case

Travis County - Elite Castle Resources LLC v. Texas Department of Transportation; K-Bar Services, Inc. v. Texas Department of Transportation - Consider action on proposal for decision by an administrative law judge concerning Texas Department of Transportation's decision to debar Elite Castle Resources, LLC, for a period of 30 months and K-Bar Services, Inc. for a period of 34 months, final order with an effective date in 2025 for ethical violations ([MO](#))

The executive director issued a notice on August 31, 2022, sanctioning both Elite Castle Resources, LLC (Elite Castle) and K-Bar Services, Inc. (K-Bar) with a 60 month debarment (with an immediate suspension), disqualifying Elite Castle and K-Bar from entering into contracts, participating as a subcontractor, or participating as a supplier of materials. Elite Castle and K-Bar requested an administrative hearing and on May 23, 2025, the State Office of Administrative Hearings issued a proposal for decision (PFD) recommending a 30 month debarment for Elite Castle and a 34 month debarment for K-Bar, finding Elite Castle and K-Bar disclosed bid information and failed to inform the Texas Department of Transportation (department) of violations, violating the department's rules of ethical conduct. Elite Castle and K-Bar filed exceptions to the PFD and on October 5, 2025, the administrative law judge denied those exceptions and made no changes to the PFD.

8. Water Control and Improvement District Relocation Reimbursement

Victoria County - Consider the approval of a request from the Victoria County Water Control & Improvement District #1 to make the relocation of the Victoria County Water Control & Improvement District #1's utility facilities required by the SH 185 highway improvement project an expense of the state under Transportation Code §203.092(a-4) ([MO](#))

Texas Administrative Code, Chapter 21, Subchapter B, §21.25 sets forth the requirements for a utility to qualify for reimbursement under this program. Payment for this relocation will not cause the Texas Department of Transportation to exceed \$10 million in any fiscal year. The utility is a political subdivision with a financial condition that prevents the utility from being able to pay the cost in full or in part or, if paid at that time, the payment would adversely affect the utility's ability to operate or provide essential services to its customers. The utility is a political subdivision, or owned or operated by a political subdivision, that has a population of less than 5,000 and is located within a county that has been included in at least five disaster declarations made by the president of the United States of America in a period of six years preceding the proposed date of the relocation.

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9. **Eminent Domain Proceedings**

Various Counties - Consider the authorization of the filing of condemnation proceedings to acquire real property by eminent domain for non-controlled and controlled access highways (see attached itemized list) ([MO](#))

Texas Transportation Commission findings, determinations, and authorizations for the state, by motion made in accordance with Senate Bill 18, 82nd Legislature, Regular Session, 2011, to acquire by eminent domain, upon the payment of adequate and just compensation, various ownership interests in specific parcels of real property that are needed to develop or improve both non-controlled and controlled access state highways, to include requesting the state attorney general to bring and pursue condemnation suits relating to those specific parcels of real property described in the attached itemized list.

10. **Routine Minute Orders and Reports**

a. **Donations to the Department**

Various Districts - Consider the acknowledgment of donations with a value of \$500 or more, including donations of money, materials, services, or real property, that are made to the Texas Department of Transportation (department) for the purpose of assisting the department in carrying out its functions and duties or for improving access to or from a highway on the state highway system (see attached itemized list) ([MO](#))

State statutes require the Texas Transportation Commission (commission) to acknowledge the acceptance of a gift to the Texas Department of Transportation that is valued at \$500 or more. By the adoption of this minute order, the commission acknowledges the receipt and acceptance of the property specified in the minute order.

b. **Real Estate Dispositions**

The Texas Transportation Commission must approve the sales, transfers, and exchanges of state rights of way and other real properties that are no longer needed for a state highway purpose. It must also approve, accept, and acknowledge donations to the state of real property that is valued at \$500 or more.

- (1) **Austin County** - US 90/SL 350 - Consider the sale of right of way to an abutting landowner ([MO](#))

The district has recommended that the Texas Transportation Commission determine that the land is no longer needed for highway purposes. An abutting landowner has requested to purchase the land, and it may be sold to the requester.

- (2) **Cooke County** - US 82 - Consider the sale of right of way to the city of Gainesville, Texas ([MO](#))

The district has recommended that the Texas Transportation Commission determine that the land is no longer needed for highway purposes. The city of Gainesville (city) has requested to purchase the land, and it may be sold to the city.

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10. **Routine Minute Orders and Reports (continued)**

b. **Real Estate Dispositions (continued)**

- (3) **Denton County** - US 377 - Consider the exchange of real property as part of a transaction to acquire real property needed for a state highway purpose ([MO](#))
The district has recommended that the Texas Transportation Commission (commission) determine that the land to be conveyed by the state in the exchange is no longer needed for a state highway purpose. The governor, on the recommendation of the commission, may execute a deed exchanging an interest in real property acquired but not needed for a highway purpose as whole or partial consideration for another interest in real property needed for a state highway purpose.
- (4) **Ellis County** - FM 85 - Consider an easement release to the underlying fee owner ([MO](#))
The district has recommended that the Texas Transportation Commission determine that the easement is no longer needed for highway purposes. The easement may be released to the underlying fee owner.
- (5) **Harris County** - Old Katy Road - Consider the sale of right of way to the Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 537 ([MO](#))
The district has recommended that the Texas Transportation Commission determine that the land is no longer needed for state highway purposes. The Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 537 (MUD) has requested to purchase the land, and it may be sold to the MUD.
- (6) **Harris County** - I-10 - Consider authorizing the Texas Department of Transportation to enter into a lease agreement with the University of Houston System to lease land for motor vehicle parking beneath elevated portions of I-10 ([MO](#))
This minute order authorizes the Texas Department of Transportation to enter into a lease of real property with the University of Houston System, which real property is to be used for a purpose of the University of Houston System. The Texas Transportation Commission is to consider waiving the fair market value requirement for this lease to an institution of higher education for a purpose of the institution.
- (7) **Shelby County** - US 96 - Consider the sale of right of way to an abutting landowner ([MO](#))
The district has recommended that the Texas Transportation Commission determine that the land is no longer needed for highway purposes. An abutting landowner has requested to purchase the land, and it may be sold to the requester.

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10. **Routine Minute Orders and Reports (continued)**

c. **Reports**

(1) **Compliance Division Report** ([Report](#))

State law requires the Texas Transportation Commission (commission) to establish a compliance program, which must include a Compliance Division to oversee the program. The Compliance Division is responsible for acting to prevent and detect serious breaches of Texas Department of Transportation (department) policy, fraud, waste, and abuse of office, including any acts of criminal conduct within the department. The Compliance Division is required to provide a monthly report to the commission regarding investigations and a summary of information relating to trends and recommendations.

(2) **Environmental Report**

Consider the acceptance of the report on projects being processed under the procedures of Transportation Code, Chapter 201, Subchapter I-1 (Report)

The report identifies projects with a local government sponsor being processed under the environmental review procedures set forth in Transportation Code, Chapter 201, Subchapter I-1. A report must be submitted twice a year to the Texas Transportation Commission, as required by Transportation Code, §201.762(a).

d. **Transportation Planning**

LBJ East, Midtown Express, and DFW Connector - Various Counties -

Consider concurrence with the Regional Transportation Council of the North Central Texas Council of Governments' funding of construction and other project development costs of projects to be advanced through the use of payments received from the respective toll projects in accordance with the respective project agreements ([MO](#))

The Texas Department of Transportation has established separate funds to account for and track projects and project costs funded with surplus toll revenue and Comprehensive Development Agreement concession payments from the LBJ East, Midtown Express, and DFW Connector projects. This minute order consolidates the Regional Toll Revenue items and authorizes the funding of projects or project costs. The project costs to be funded were selected through a cooperative process with the Regional Transportation Council.

e. **Speed Zones**

Various Counties - Consider the establishment or alteration of regulatory and construction speed zones on various sections of highways in the state ([MO](#))

This minute order establishes or alters regulatory and construction speed zones on various sections of highways in the state.

11. **Executive Session** Pursuant to Government Code, Chapter 551

Section 551.071 - Consultation with and advice from legal counsel regarding any item on this agenda, pending or contemplated litigation, or other legal matters.

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OPEN COMMENT PERIOD - At the conclusion of all other agenda items, the commission will allow an open comment period, not to exceed one hour, to receive public comment on any other matter that is under the jurisdiction of the department. No action will be taken. Each speaker will be allowed a maximum of three minutes. Speakers must be signed up prior to the beginning of the open comment period.
