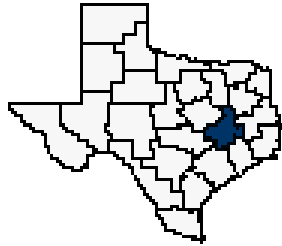




DISTRICT PROFILE

MAJOR PROJECTS UNDERWAY:

- IH 45 Widening to 6 lanes in Walker County south of SH 30 in Huntsville - \$200 million
- FM 2818 Widening in College Station - \$50 million
- FM 60 Widening in Burleson County east of SH 36 - \$34 million

PLANNED MAJOR PROJECTS:

- SH 21 Widening in Madison County - \$190 million
- SL 1853 New Location in Madison County - \$250 million
- SH 6 Widening in Bryan/College Station - \$470 million
- IH 45 Widening to 6 lanes through Huntsville north of SH 30 - \$320 million
- US 290/SH 36 Interchange in Brenham - \$230 million
- US 79 Widening in Leon County - \$165 million
- SH 105 Widening from SH 249 to SH 6 in Grimes County - \$160 million
- SH 6 Widening from Brazos County to Hearne - \$160 million

SAFETY: The Bryan District's number one priority is safety. We are committed to reducing traffic fatalities by focusing on engineering and education.

BRIDGES: We have 1235 On-System bridges and 691 off-system bridges. For a total of 1926 bridges.

MAINTENANCE: We invest approximately \$100 million annually on maintaining our system. This includes pavement, signing, striping, and drainage.
