KEY CORRIDOR PLANS

- I-35 Northeast Expansion (NEX): Expansion to improve I-35 between FM 1103 and N. Walters Street is underway. I-35 NEX Central between I-410 N to FM 3009 began Summer 2022 and is expected to be completed in 2027. Phase 1 of I-35 NEX South between I-410 N and I-410 S broke ground late Spring 2024. Phase 2 and 3 and I-NEX North will be under construction within the next 5 years.
- Loop 1604: Expansion to a 10-lane expressway between SH 16 (Bandera Road) and I-35 with direct connectors at I-10. Segment 1 and 3 between SH 16 (Bandera Road) to US 281 began in Spring 2021. Segment 2 at the I-10 interchange began in 2022. Segment 4 from US 281 to Redland Road began broke ground Spring 2024. Segment 5 and 6 between Redland Road to I-35 scheduled to be under construction in the next 5 years,
- I-10: Ongoing expansion and improvement projects between I-410 and FM 1518 and to Seguin is under construction.
- Comal County: Hwy 46, FM 1103 expansion currently under construction.

MAINTENANCE: Our maintenance budget is about \$100 million annually. Our major expenditures include pavement preservation, traffic management and roadside maintenance.

SAFETY: Our safety program focuses on reducing traffic fatalities through education, engineering and enforcement. This involves safety campaigns, roadway upgrades including pedestrian facilities and clearer pavement marking, grant funding to police agencies like our Selective Traffic Enforcement Program and the Highway Emergency Response Operator (HERO) program.
