- IH 10 in Colorado County East of Columbus: Add additional lanes in both directions - \$750 million
- US 59 in Wharton County from Wharton North to Fort Bend C/L: Upgrade to interstate standards -\$450 million
- SH 80 in Gonzales County: Add passing lanes (Super 2) - \$55 million

MAINTENANCE: The Yoakum District spends an average of \$18 million to seal coat 350 miles of roadway each year. The Yoakum District also crack seals approximately 1,500 lane miles of roadway each year to preserve the pavement life.

corridors: The Yoakum District is responsible for portions of IH-10, US 59, US 87, US 77, US 183, SH 36, and SH 71. The Yoakum District is currently working on multiple construction and design projects to upgrade US 59 throughout the district to I-69 standards and add additional lanes to IH 10.

SAFETY: The Yoakum District's safety program currently has over \$91 million budgeted for the next 4 years. We have projects underway to widen roads, add turn lanes, add median barrier and install sidewalks. Also, the district is working on adding new traffic signals, upgrading existing traffic signals and adding overhead lighting. Revised 01/06/2025.
