P RT BA KGROUND ND NSTRU T NS

1. NTR DU T N

The Texas Department of Transportation ("TxDOT"), a agency of the State of Texas, has issued sealed submittals of qualifications ("QSs") for entities ("Proposers") desiring to develop, design and construct, or operate, individual, federal, state and local facilities along a portion of the State Highway (SH) 99, between Gladewater and Jacksonville ("Project"), pursuant to a Public-Private Partnership Agreement ("P3A"). Development of the Project is a crucial element in addressing severe traffic congestion existing in the Houston area.

TxDOT is issuing this Request for Qualifications ("RFQ") in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 223 of the Texas Transportation Code (the "Code") (which can be found at <http://www.state.texas.us/Docs/TN/h/TN.223.h>); Sections 9.6, 27.1-27.9 and 27.90-27.92 of Title 43, Texas Administrative Code (the "Rules") (available at [http://texasos.state.texas.us/Is/ub/eadac\\$ex.view.ac](http://texasos.state.texas.us/Is/ub/eadac$ex.view.ac)); and other applicable provisions of law. Proposers shall submit responses to this RFQ will be invited to submit proposals ("Proposals") in response to the requests for proposals ("RFP"). A copy of the Texas Transportation Commission's ("Commission") Rule 112629 dated March 31, 2011 authorizing issuance of the RFQ is available at http://www.txdot.gov/about_us/commission/2011_meetings/documents/2011_7b.pdf. A copy of the Commission's Rule 112725 dated June 30, 2011 authorizing development of the project by the Gladewater local entity is available at http://www.txdot.gov/about_us/commission/2011_meetings/documents/june_30/7b.pdf.

TxDOT has determined to provide second opportunity flexibility to propose innovative solutions to enhance safety and efficiency and delivery of this Project, achieve the Project goals, and needed consequences to the public. Through the RFP, TxDOT will seek Proposals to develop the Project through design-build and/or full construction delivery approaches.

This RFQ provides for second delivery options including submittals of qualifications (for one or both of the two delivery models to be considered). **Proposers must submit a full and complete separate QS, meeting the requirements herein, for each delivery model for which they wish to be considered for**

shortlisting. Proposer may submit no more than one QS for each delivery model for which it wishes to be considered for shortlisting.

TxDOT has assembled a set of documents relating to the Project ("Project Documents"). The Project Documents will be made available on the Project Website upon issuance of this RFQ at www.txdot.gov/gaddakwa.h ("Project Website"). TxDOT will charge \$25.00 for the costs of providing electronic copies of the Project Documents.

2. REPORTING AND PROJECT TEAM

SH 99 is a proposed 180-mile continuous freeway interchange highway using several counties in the Houston area. It is divided into 11 segments designed through I-2 as detailed on the map included as Exhibit A ("Gaddakwa Map"). All segments are planned to be delivered by his RFQ as the "Gaddakwa." The Gaddakwa segments serve individual areas of the city and are marked with ovals and a delivery schedule for implementation and milestones which govern the delivery of the highway over time. The development of the project, TxDOT has been involved since the initial planning stages of the Gaddakwa. As described below, TxDOT has been involved in the development of the project of the Gaddakwa has been the subject of his RFQ.

I acknowledge with Texas Transportation Code Section 228.0111, TxDOT and the counties in which the Gaddakwa is situated are entitled to make Valuation Waiver Agreement ("MVW Agreement"). The March 25, 2009 MVW Agreement defines the "Minimum Standard" and the "Ultimate Standard" of the Gaddakwa. Additionally, the MVW Agreement includes certain standards, conditions and guidelines for development, construction and operation of the Gaddakwa. A copy of the MVW Agreement is included in the Project Documents.

2.1 Project Goals

The following goals have been developed for the Gaddakwa.

1. Build the Gaddakwa Minimum Standard as quickly as possible.
2. Acquire high-quality construction documents for the Ultimate Standard as quickly as possible.

3. Deliver the Utilization Score which demonstrates a sufficient level of coverage and access to all areas of the project area.

The following objectives have been developed for the Project:

1. Efficiently utilize available funding resources to deliver a quality project that will serve the public interest of the community.
2. Complete the Project schedule and achieve the highest degree of quality possible.
3. Improve overall accessibility within the Project area by providing additional access points and ease of access to all areas.
4. Improve service delivery levels by the Project segment to increase overall level of service provided.
5. Increase regional and local safety by identifying and addressing potential hazards and emergency evacuation routes. Develop a safe travel plan with high accident rates.
6. Extend and support economic opportunities in the region by providing the ability to transport goods, equipment, supplies, and services to and from the area.
7. Maintain a safe environment for all Project employees and the public at all times.
8. Minimize construction impacts during construction.
9. Communicate quality and safety goals to the region.

2.2 Description of the Proposed Contracting Opportunity

TxDOT intends, through its procurement process, to award a P3A which involves developing a contract ("Development") that will result in achieving some of Project goals stated above. TxDOT anticipates seeking Proposals for the Project and, after Proposals are evaluated, selecting one or more proposals for the P3A: either a design-build P3A or a toll concession P3A as described below. Proposers are encouraged to submit single QSs for each of the delivery models under consideration or a sub-set of two QSs, one for each of these potential projects.

2.2.1 Design-Build opportunity

TxDOT will include design-build P3A will include a design-build agreement ("DBA") and a construction management agreement ("CMA"). The form of the design-build P3A will obligate the Developer to: (1) develop, design and construct the Project; and (2) a TxDOT's sole responsibility, to coordinate and manage the Project for a period of time to be determined by TxDOT, but not to exceed 15 years. TxDOT will execute the DBA will include a fixed price contract for the Project. The DBA will set forth the terms of the Developer's construction which are contained in the contract and will be based on the cost of the work and the cost of the Project. The Project manager advised to review the draft Technical Sheet for the DBA attached as Exhibit B-1 for additional details regarding the Developer's responsibilities and obligations under the Contract.

The CMA will add essential elements to the design-build Project facilities in order to serve all users, including (i) giving TxDOT the sole right to award contracts for services; (ii) giving TxDOT the sole right to exercise certain options to have the Developer assume certain responsibilities for the Project; and (iii) equipping the Developer to provide certain services to the Project which were specified in the contract. With respect to the construction of the Project, it is understood that TxDOT will hold five-year options, exercisable by TxDOT, to its sole discretion, to provide certain services to the Project. The exercise of options shall be equivalent to TxDOT exercising a future option. Furthermore, TxDOT does not intend to exercise certain subsequent contracts if a user has been exercised. Should the Project manager be equivalent to the Project manager of the previous year, he or she will be equivalent to the Project manager of the previous year. The Project manager advised to review the draft Technical Sheet for the CMA attached as Exhibit B-2 for additional details regarding the Project's responsibilities and obligations under the Contract. Future users of the Project will be subject to the terms and conditions of the Project's contract, including the Project's obligations under the RFP.

2.2.2 Toll concession opportunity

If TxDOT chooses to utilize a full toll concession approach, it is anticipated that the P3A for the Project will grant a concession to the Developer for a period of up to 52 years and obligate the Developer to (i) develop, design and construct certain parts of the Project, (ii) invest equivalent funds for such purposes, and (iii) operate and maintain the Project, including the coordination of construction, the management of the Project, and the provision of certain services to the Project. The concession P3A will grant the Developer the right to collect tolls from users of the Project during the term of the concession, subject to a maximum toll rate set by TxDOT. The Project manager advised to review the draft Technical Sheet for the Toll Concession P3A attached as Exhibit B-3 for additional details regarding the Project's responsibilities and obligations under the Project.

2.2.3 SB 142 Committee and Determination of Delivery Model

As required by SB 1420, which was passed in the 86th Texas legislative session, a committee (the "SB 1420 Committee"), composed of the respective members of TxDOT, HCTRA, MCTRAs and HGAC, was formed to determine (i) the disposition of the Project's financial risk, (ii) the methodology for financing the Project, and (iii) the tolling structure and the methodologies to be used for the Project. The Texas Transportation Commission has adopted rules defining the processes and procedures under which the SB 1420 Committee will operate.

TxDOT, as a member of the SB 1420 Committee, is working with the SB 1420 Committee to make the design-build law available in the selection process. There are three possible approaches: a design-build procurement, a toll concession procurement or a combination of both. TxDOT anticipates that the SB 1420 Committee will make its decision in a timely manner. If the SB 1420 Committee does not make a decision in time, the RFP will be issued. If the SB 1420 Committee does not issue a request for proposals, TxDOT will issue a request for proposals for the design-build and concession phases of the RFP.

If the procurement involves a combination of both design-build and concession methodologies, TxDOT will publish in the RFP a methodology for evaluating bids in a clear and concise manner. It will also provide the Project's value to the State. See Part A, Section 3.1 for further information regarding the evaluation process.

2.3 Project Scope

2.3.1 Design-Build Scope

The design-build approach, developed by the Developer's scope for the Project will include the design, construction and operation, capital and maintenance of Segments F-1, F-2 and G of the Grand Parkway. The Developer's design, construction and operation of the Grand Parkway will include Segments D and E. The Developer will be responsible for coordinating the construction and operation of Segments F-1, F-2 and G of the Grand Parkway with the segments E, ECO, AC 0 and the easements of Segment E.

2.3.2 Toll Concession Scope

The full toll concession approach, the scope of the Developer's obligations for the Project will include the development, design, construction, financing, maintenance, and operation of the Grand Parkway for the duration of the concession period. The concession period will begin on the date of the opening of Segment E and end on the date of completion of the Project.

Guard Parks will be finalized and included in the overall concession Project scope as described as follows:

- Segment F-1, F-2 and Guard Parks will be developed, designed and constructed: Segment F-1, F-2 and Guard Parks will be developed, designed and constructed under the P3A.
- Segment F-1, F-2 and Guard Parks will be developed, designed and constructed: The location of Segment F-1, F-2 and Guard Parks will be determined by the location of Segment D located off of FM 1093 in Ford County, Segment E, Segment F-1, F-2, and Guard Parks will be developed, designed and constructed under the P3A. Under separate contracts, TxDOT is responsible for construction of Segment D and E in Hays County which will be leased to the Developer.

2.3.3 Project Overview

The following table provides additional information regarding the proposed scope for the Project, including segments, legal descriptions, dimensions, initial direct connectors, status of environmental approvals, and target opening dates.

2.6 Project Environmental Status

A description of the current environmental status for each of the Project segments is included in Exhibit C. Additional environmental documents shall be made available due to design changes, alignment revisions, and other factors. TxDOT is currently evaluating the Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) prepared by FHWA for the project area and the FHWA action items identified in the Project Environmental Assessment available for review as specified in Part A, Section 1.

2.7 Construction Cost Estimates

TxDOT's current cost estimates for the individual segments are developed in Segment F-1, F-2 and General for the P3A area, totaling \$840 million (\$2011) based on the individual cost descriptions in Part A, Section 2.2.

The estimated costs reflect the current developed schedule for the environmental and all studies for the initial Project segments and cost estimates. In addition, the estimated design documents include design, right-of-way, utility adjustments, and collection systems engineering, operations and maintenance costs.

2.8 Funding available for Development Costs

If a design-build approach is selected, TxDOT identifies opportunities for the design, construction and capitalization of the Project through various funding sources and funding will be provided for the Development.

TxDOT is responsible for design and construction of Segment D and E. Under a concession approach, it is also TxDOT funding will be available for the remainder of the Project. TxDOT identifies available funding through the Transportation Alternatives Program and also for allocation to Private Activity Bonds (PABs). Receipt of these potential funding sources for the Project is subject to federal equity and availability. These programs will be eligible for use by the Project if a proposal is made available. The RFP will provide further details regarding TxDOT's expectations relating to Project financing under each of the delivery models.

2.9 Right-of-Way Acquisition

TxDOT has acquired Project right-of-way ("ROW") for Segment D. TxDOT is currently evaluating ROW areas for Segment F-1, F-2 and General. ROW areas for Segment F-1, F-2 and General are expected to be available in the fourth quarter of 2011.

2.1 .1 Geotechnical nvestigation Program

2.1 .2 Utility investigation

TxDOT is currently conducting Level A SUE investigations within the Project ROW. TxDOT expects SUE information to be available for review by Project closeout 2012.

As indicated earlier, eligible utility adjustments / relocation expenses, Development should assume overall project design authority for the Project unless otherwise ordered. TxDOT will be responsible for preparing engineering reports causing necessary utility relocation costs/adjustments to be included in the contract with a licensor(s) for the cost of association with utility relocation costs, except where existing utility uses are legal and/or such costs.

2.1 .3 Hazardous Materials Investigations

The environmental assessment document includes site-specific details regarding the results of hazard assessments and investigations conducted by the Project team and available for review as provided in Part A, Section 1. TxDOT is currently assessing what, if any, additional hazard assessments and investigations will be collected in connection with the Project and a seek input from the Project team to facilitate his assessment during the review process.

2.1 .4 Detention Plan

The Project includes design and construction standards. TxDOT will be responsible for standard design and will obtain the equivalent USACE Section 404 Individual Permit. Additional details and equivalents will be set forth in the RFP.

2.1 .5 Esthetic Treatment

TxDOT anticipates that the P3A will require the Development to follow current TxDOT Housing Disclosure guidelines within the Project boundaries. These guidelines are available on the Project Website. An additional detail sheet shall be set forth in the RFP.

2.1 .6 Railroad Coordination

TxDOT is currently coordinating with affected railroads regarding rail corridor crossings. TxDOT anticipates that the P3A will require the Development to take over coordination of rail corridor crossings. Efforts and design shall include rail corridor crossings in accordance with the rail corridor equivalents. Railroad crossings within the Project limits is anticipated to be addressed below.

2.12 SB 142 Committee and Toll Rate Policy

If a concession delivery model is selected for the development of the Project, the SB 1420 Committee described in Part A, Section 2.2.3 will determine the tolling structure and the toll rates to be used for the Project. It is anticipated that the initial toll rates will be determined by the tolling structure of a concession P3A will be consistent with the MVW Agreement.

2.13 Toll Collection System Development

TxDOT anticipates using the design-build P3A, TxDOT's Statewide Toll System. The existing (which is currently being considered) will provide facilities, equipment and services for the toll collection system. TxDOT currently anticipates that Development will be equipped to coordinate activities with the Statewide Toll System. The existing . Future implementation of the Development's scope of work for tolling facilities will be set forth in the RFP.

The RFP will have further information regarding the equipment required for toll collection system to be included in the Development's scope of work. The Development will be equipped to coordinate activities with local authorities.

3. REPORT AND PROCUREMENT PROCESS

3.1 Overall Process

3.1.1 Procurement Phases

TxDOT reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to modify the following procedures in accordance with applicable law and/or addressees' best interests of TxDOT and the State of Texas, including but not limited to those of the delivery models under consideration.

TxDOT will evaluate the qualifications of subcontractors ("QSs") it receives in response to its RFQ and determine which ones are eligible to receive the RFP. Proposals submitted in response to QSs for other than delivery models are not considered. In addition, subject to Part A, Section 5.7, a proposal may be offered for delivery models that are different from the delivery models.

If only one responsive QS is received for a Project delivery model, TxDOT will award the (a) proceed with the procurement process for delivery models for the sole Project or (b) proceed with the procurement process for the anticipated delivery

Specific provisions regarding the award of the contract shall be included in the RFP. The award will be made to the Proposers who are chosen.

TxDOT anticipates awarding a contract to execute a P3A for the Project in late 2012.

3.9 Project Standards

TxDOT anticipates including the RFP all proposed specific standards and specific requirements, as well as baseline Project definitions. The RFP also includes Project objectives, following TxDOT's code of conduct, except standards and deviations from the code of ethics. All requests for deviations shall follow the code of ethics and shall be submitted to the RFP. Proposers should note, however, that they are responsible for their own design and construction documents.

4. QUALITY REQUIREMENTS AND SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

4.1 General

TxDOT expects QSs to submit their RFQs to provide enough information about their qualifications so as to allow TxDOT to evaluate and consider them. Each proposer shall submit qualifications for one or more models under consideration as specified by the proposer. 5.3 Qualifications Evaluation Criteria and Weighting

Each eligible QS assessing all of the "ass/fail" qualification criteria listed below will be evaluated according to the applicable design-build delivery model. TxDOT will evaluate each of the QSs (a) for the design-build delivery model according to the criteria in Part A, Section 5.4, and (b) for the full construction delivery model according to the criteria in Part A, Section 5.5. The relative weightings of each evaluation criterion will be assigned by each agency as described in Parts A, Sections 5.4 and 5.5.1 through 5.5.4 below.

5.4 Design-Build Evaluation Criteria

Each eligible QS for the design-build delivery model assessing all of the "ass/fail" qualification criteria listed below in Part A, Section 5.2 will be evaluated according to the applicable design-build delivery model. Consideration of subfactors will be given to each agency's assessment of the delivery model's ability to provide the services and facilities described in the proposal. Construction subfactors shall be of equal value to each other.

5.4.1 Project Experience (7 % Weighting)

The background and experience of the proposer, individual entities, and each technical personnel involved in developing, designing, constructing, and maintaining comparable projects will be evaluated in accordance with the criteria in his Section 5.4.1. The evaluation criteria will be Subsection (a) a set of equal items or a set of he evaluation criteria in Subsection (b) a set of general items or a set of specific criteria in Subsection (c).

(a) Experience of the Proposer Team

The experience of which the proposer entity consists shall follow:

- The experience and depth of the proposer's individual entities' experience in developing, designing, and constructing comparable projects; and
- The experience and depth of the proposer's individual entities' experience in developing, designing, and constructing comparable projects; and

(b) Experience of the Technical Personnel

The experience and depth of experience of the age entity and each technical personnel involved in the proposal is set out in Part B, Volume 3, Section C.

(c) Management and Team Structure

7.8 Decision on Protest

The Executive Director or the Executive Director's designee shall issue a written decision regarding the offers within 30 days after filing of the appealed sales or offers. 7.9 Protestant's Payment of Costs
