Introduction

The Commercial Signs Licensing and Permitting System (CSLAP) allows users to apply for or renew permits and licenses, search records, or submit complaints. This job aid describes the process of applying for an Interstate or Primary System Highway Signs Permit in CSLAP.


Apply for Interstate or Primary System Highway Signs Permit in CSLAP

To apply for an Interstate or Primary System Highway Signs Permit with CSLAP, follow the steps below.

1. Click the CSLAP Login/Registration link from the TxDOT.gov website.



2. The Commercial Signs Licensing and Permitting homepage will appear. Select Log In to get to your CSLAP homepage.




3. Select Create Case.








5. Select Permit Type Interstate or Primary System Highway Signs.






11. Enter Location of Proposed or Existing Sign Site.








