FTA reviewed the transit element of the November 2024 revisions to the FY 2025-2028 STIP, received on December 23, 2024, with the Texas Department of Transportation's (TxDOT) approval letter (dated December 23, 2024). Based upon our review of the November 2024 revisions to the FY 2025-2028 STIP, FTA approved the transit element on January 14, 2025. Please note STIP approval of projects that are not federally funded is not intended to provide federal endorsement or action.

Revisions to the transit element of FY 2025-2028 STIP for the El Paso, Dallas/Fort Worth, Houston, and San Antonio non-attainment areas were reviewed for consistency with their currently conforming Metropolitan Transportation Plans (MTPs). Based upon this review, we found that the transit element of the Transportation Improvement Programs (TIPs) for these areas conform.
