

Texas Motor Vehicle Traffic Crash Facts Calendar Year 2022

- The Fatality Rate on Texas roadways for 2022 was 1.52 deaths per hundred million vehicle miles traveled. This is a 3.09% decrease from 2021.
- Texas experienced a decrease in the number of motor vehicle traffic fatalities.
 The 2022 death toll of 4,407 was a decrease of 1.10% from the 4,456 deaths recorded in 2021.
- There were 15,303 serious injury crashes in Texas in 2022 with 18,885 people sustaining a serious injury*.
- The annual vehicle miles traveled in Texas during 2022 reached 290.891 billion, an increase of 2.06% over the 285.028 billion traveled in 2021.
- Fatalities in traffic crashes in rural areas of the state accounted for 51.58% of the state's traffic fatalities. There were 2,273 deaths in rural traffic crashes.
- Single vehicle, run-off the road crashes resulted in 1,430 deaths in 2022. This was 32.45% of all motor vehicle traffic deaths in 2022.
- In 2022 there were 1,020 people killed in crashes occurring in intersections or related to an intersection.
- There were 634 people killed in head-on crashes in 2022.
- There were no deathless days on Texas roadways in 2022.
- There were two crashes that resulted in 6 or more fatalities in 2022.
- Friday, July 22nd was the deadliest day in 2022 with thirty (30) persons killed in traffic crashes. September was the deadliest month with 423 persons killed.

- Based on reportable crashes in 2022:
 - 1 person was killed every 1 hour59 minutes
 - 1 person was injured every 2 minutes 9 seconds
 - 1 reportable crash occurred every 57 seconds
- Of all persons killed in vehicles where restraint usage was applicable and usage was known in 2022, 48.38% were reported as not restrained when the fatal crash occurred.
- 244,337 persons were injured in motor vehicle traffic crashes in 2022.
- There were 562 motorcyclists (operators and passengers) killed in 2022. thirty-eight percent (38%) of motorcyclists killed were not wearing helmets at the time of the crash.
- Pedestrian fatalities totaled 815 in 2022. This is a 0.49% decrease from 2021.
- Pedalcyclist fatalities totaled 91 in 2022.
 This is a 1.11% increase from 2021.
- In 2022, there were 1,263 people killed in motor vehicle traffic crashes where a driver was under the influence of alcohol. This is 28.66% of the total number of people killed in motor vehicle traffic crashes.
- During 2022, more DUI Alcohol crashes were reported in the hour between 2:00 am and 2:59 am than any other hour of the day. Also, more of these crashes occurred on Saturday than any other day of the week.
- In 2022, there were 487 people killed in crashes involving distracted driving. This is an 12.47% increase from 2021.
- There were no fatalities caused by a bridge collapse in 2022.

^{*}Effective with the 2010 Annual Summary reports, the definition of "Serious Injury" was changed to only include "Incapacitating Injury". Therefore, Serious Injury data cannot be compared to prior years.
